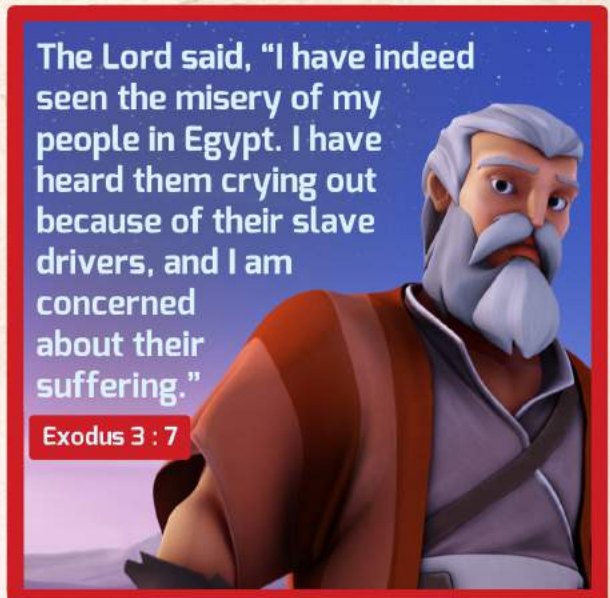

Activity : Take A Hint

Hint 2: Moses stretched me out over the Red Sea.

Answer: **Moses' rod.**

Answer: ***Moses.***

Who are we?

Hint 1: We followed the Israelites in the wilderness.

Hint 2: We drowned in the Red Sea.

Answer: ***Pharaoh's army.***

Who are we?

Hint 1: We made bricks.

Hint 2: God rescued us out of Egypt.

Answer: ***Israelites, or Hebrew people.***

What am I?

Hint 1: I was the first plague.

Hint 2: I am red.

Answer: ***Plague of blood in the river.***

What am I?

Hint 1: God ordered that I should be put on the door posts of the Israelite's homes.

Hint 2: The angel passed over when he saw me.

Answer: ***Lamb's blood.***

What am I?

Hint 1: Moses stopped to see me in the wilderness.

Hint 2: I was on fire but did not burn up.

Answer: ***Burning bush.***
